

# Lumbersports Skills Competition

## Rules and Regulations

The Lumbersports Skills Competition is open to Junior Lumbersports teams from across Nova Scotia. The Competition takes place at 4-H Nova Scotia Provincial Rally.

**Age Requirements:** The team must have a maximum average age of 13. Members must be between 9 and 15 years of age.

**Saws will be provided for the following events:**

**Crosscut:** old-fashioned ribbon saws (2-person event)

**Single Pulp:** 36-inch Hardpoint (1-person event)

**Double Pulp:** 42-inch Hardpoint (2-person event)

*All equipment, except for personal protective equipment, and that required for the water boil event, will be provided for the Lumbersports Skills Competition.*

- Lumbersports Skills teams will compete in a single round of events in the morning.
- Each member may compete in a maximum of two events.
- Members may only participate on either the Junior Lumbersports Skills Team or Senior Lumbersports Team. A member may not compete on both.
- Each team will be given the opportunity to practice with the provided competition saws, prior to the competition.

A perpetual trophy and medallions will be awarded to the winning Lumbersports Skills team at 4-H Night in Nova Scotia on Saturday of Provincial Rally.

**NOTE:** All regulations and safety concerns outlined in the Lumbersports Competition Guidelines document apply to the Lumbersports Skills Competition.
