The Young Speakers for Agriculture Competition will be held on Friday 30 September 2022. 4-H Nova Scotia sponsors the winner chosen to represent Nova Scotia at the Young Speakers for Agriculture competition at the Royal Winter Fair in Toronto. The award covers travel and accommodations at the Royal Winter Fair, Toronto.

Members eligible must:

- Be between 16 and 24 years of age as of 1 January of current 4-H year.
- Be a current member of the 4-H program or have been registered for at least two years.
- Deliver their speech in either of Canada's official languages, English or French. (If your speech is in French, please indicate so when you apply.)
- Give a timed five to seven-minute prepared speech on one of the following topics, as well as introduce and thank another speaker.
- Contestants may choose to use a flip chart or appropriate posters to illustrate their talk. Slides, films, videos, or overhead projectors will not be allowed.

Topics for 2022:

- The implications of supply chain issues on Canada's food supply.
- Rising global water and temperature levels: What does it mean for agriculture?
- Unexpected careers: Here are three jobs you didn't know were linked to agriculture.
- Alternative agriculture: What opportunities await Canadian farmers?
- Is local food sustainable?
- Why the world is eating more fish and what it means for Canadian aquaculture.
- I realized I wanted a career in agriculture when.

Once a member has won the Nova Scotia Young Speakers for Agriculture Competition, they are not allowed to compete again.
