DIRECTIONS:

- Start course at Point A and move throughout the course by filling in the answers to the questions asked.
 - Note: All distances and bearings are measured to the nearest degree or meters. This is not a timed event. However, a very generous time limit has been set so that members do not spend hours on the course. Points will be deducted if you exceed the time limit.
- When you get to point "C", you will notice three posts numbered 1, 2 & 3.
- Write down what post is located at the bearing listed in Question #5.
- At the map station, fill in the magnetic bearing from the map provided;
- Double check all your answers to make sure the judge can read them!!
- Hand in your scorecard as you are all done! Results will be posted.

Scoring: Each question has a value of 10 points. For each degree or meter that you are off from the official measurement, 1 point will be deducted from the total point value of that question.
