

Youth Advisory Committee 4-H Nova Scotia YAC Responsibilities



If you are the successful applicant as the Nova Scotia Member to the Youth Advisory Committee (YAC) of 4-H Canada, your additional roles and responsibilities as the Nova Scotia YAC member will be:

- Participate as a member of the Board of Directors of 4-H Nova Scotia. As a member of the Board of Directors, you are also a member of the Nova Scotia 4-H Council. The Board of Directors meets at minimum five (5) times a year and the Council meets at minimum once a year in Debert. (Mileage reimbursement will be provided by 4-H NS). Note that Board members are expected to serve on Committees of the Board.
- Participate at Provincial Events (Provincial Rally, Atlantic Members Conference and 4-H Nova Scotia Provincial Show) in various capacities (i.e. opening and closing ceremonies).
- Submission of a written report at the AGM of Nova Scotia 4-H Council. The report should include an outline of your activities both nationally and provincially for the year; updates from 4-H Canada and the Working Groups in which you have participated as a YAC representative.
- Upon fulfilling your term as the Nova Scotia Member to the Youth Advisory Committee, participate as a member of the selection committee for the new Nova Scotia YAC Member.
- The 4-H Nova Scotia YAC member will be appointed the responsibility of chairing the Members Voice Committee and must be able to facilitate and attend monthly committee conference calls and an annual in-person meeting. The successful candidate must be able to work in conjunction with an appointed office staff person and a committee-appointed adult advisor to carry out the work of the committee. The committee is made up of the YAC, provincial ambassadors, county representatives from each of 4-H Nova Scotia's 18 counties as well as the appointed adult advisor and 4-H NS President and Executive Director. The committee reports to the 4-H Nova Scotia Board of Directors. The 4-H Nova Scotia YAC is responsible for submitting Members Voice Committee reports for the Board and AGM.
- The 4-H NS YAC member is part of the Atlantic YAC team and encouraged to attend and act as a mentor at the Atlantic 4-H conferences.
